INCENTIVES



Energy Incentives Grant Program

Install energy saving appliances like HVAC Systems or Energy Star and get reimbursed up to \$3,000 or 50% of the cost of improvements, whichever is less



Ultra-Low Toilet Replacement Rebates

Purchase a 1.28 gallons/flush or lower toilet certified by Watersense, and receive \$50 towards the purchase price (pre-approval prior to purchase required)



Business Incentive Grant Program

Provides funding to eligible businesses for facade improvements up to \$10,000 or 50% of the cost of improvements, whichever is less. Used to promote Green Building development, Hurricane proofing, and visual development



Tree Giveaway

Provides residents with free native trees every February in Mickel Park

FLOODING RESOURCES

Due to our low-lying topography, Wilton Manors is at a high risk of experiencing negative implications of sea level rise and climate change. It is our goal to provide residents with relevant resources and information to aid them in taking preventative measures to reduce harmful effects.

Maintaining Swales and Building up Seawalls

The best way for residents to mitigate the effects of sea level rise is to raise up your seawall and to maintain your swales

Before a flood, make sure you:

- Have a plan for what to do and where to go in a flood emergency
- Know the elevation of your property in relation to nearby rivers and waterways

FLOOD INSURANCE

Prepare your property for flood damage by purchasing flood insurance. There is 25% chance that a property owner will experience a flood during the lifespan of their mortgage. Please visit www.floodsmart.gov or call the National Flood Insurance Program for information on how to purchase flood insurance
