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MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS FOR ANNUAL DOG PARK PASS

An annual Dog Park may be purchased only at one location:

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1. Bring completed application form, Colohatchee Dog Park Rules and Regulations, and the "Acceptance of Risk and Release of Liability and Waiver Form" each fully executed by all dog owners/handlers who are 18 years or older to Hagen Park Community Center.
 2. Bring supporting documentation:
 - Proof of rabies and Bordetella vaccinations for each dog that is registered to use the City's Dog Park.
 - Proof of Wilton Manors residency (if applicable, see application form for acceptable documentation).
 - Driver's license or equivalent government photo identification for all dog owners/handlers who are 18 years or older.
 3. Payment for passes:
 - Resident fee is \$30, \$0 for each additional dog.
 - Non-Resident fee is \$120, \$45 for each additional dog.
 - Hagen Park Community Center accepts cash, check or credit card as a form of payment.

How to obtain an additional key fob if lost:

1. Only one (1) key fob per application will be issued; however, if it is lost, you must apply for a replacement.
2. In order to apply, bring the following to the above location:
 - Completed application; and
 - Payment for the replacement key fob.
3. Park staff will review and issue a new key fob. Misplaced or lost key fobs will be deactivated.

PLEASE NOTE

- Bring your key fob with you each time you visit the dog park.
- Do not allow the use of your key fob by any person not listed in your application.
- If you lose your Dog Park key fob, see Park Staff for a replacement (\$10 fee).
- **DOG PARK KEY FOB WILL EXPIRE ONE (1) YEAR FROM DATE OF PURCHASE. HOWEVER, KEY FOB WILL BE DE-ACTIVATED ON THE DATE THE RABIES AND/OR BORDETELLA VACCINATION RECORD EXPIRES. ONCE PROOF OF RENEWED VACCINATION RECORD IS PROVIDED, THE KEY FOB WILL BE RE-ACTIVATED.**



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COLOHATCHEE DOG PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

Dog Park Hours of Operation

8:00am until dusk daily

Closed on Tuesday

- All dogs must be leashed until safely inside the Dog Park and returned to a leash prior to exiting the Dog Park. Owners/handlers must have one (1) leash per dog at all times.
- Dog owners/handlers must remain in the fenced area while their dogs are using the Dog Park. Owners/handlers must be in view of their dogs with voice control at all times.
- There are separately designated areas of the park for dogs of different sizes. All dog owners/handlers shall only place their dogs in the areas set aside for dogs their size.
- No communal dog water bowls may be used or left in the park.
- Dog pools are prohibited.
- Choke, spike, pinch, prong collars are not allowed inside the Dog Park.
- Aggressive dogs and female dogs in heat are not allowed inside the Dog Park. Owners/handlers must immediately leash and remove dogs from the Dog Park at the first sign of aggression, hostility, or combative behavior.**
- Keep the park clean and sanitary. All dog waste must be disposed of immediately and completely by placing the waste in the proper container.
- Each adult may have a maximum of three (3) dogs at a time inside the Dog Park.
- Puppies less than four (4) months old are not permitted inside the Dog Park.
- Owners/handlers are, at all times, solely responsible and liable for any injury or damage caused by their dogs and is fully responsible for their dogs' actions. Never leave your dog(s) unattended. If your dog inflicts an injury, you must give your name and telephone number to the other dog owner/handler before leaving.
- No digging. If your dog digs within the Dog Park, you must notify City Staff immediately to ensure the area is restored to a safe condition.
- All children under the age of 13 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- No food, treats, alcoholic beverages (soft drinks and water are allowed), strollers, bicycles, or children's toys are allowed in the dog park.
- The off-leash dog area is for dogs, their handlers, and those accompanying them. No other use is allowed. These areas are designated for recreational canine activities. It is not intended for any other purpose.
- No professional or commercial training is allowed inside the Dog Park except for City-sponsored events.
- All dogs and owners/handlers use the Dog Park at their own risk. Owners/handlers must agree to and formally execute the City's "Acceptance of Risk and Release of Liability and Waiver Form" prior to use of the Dog Park.
- Dog owners/handlers must never use their gate pass to allow another dog owner/handler into the Dog Park. Failure to abide by this rule will result in loss of Dog Park privileges. No refunds will be given. (This policy will be strictly enforced.)**
- Staff have the authority to close the park or sections of the park for any reason including maintenance, mowing, weather related problems, special events, or for the public's safety and/or health.
- Dog owners/handlers who fail to abide by rules and regulations are subject to loss of Dog Park privileges.

Note: City staff have the authority to enforce posted rules, dogs and/or their owners who violate these rules are subject to removal from the park and possible suspension or cancellation of membership. The City of Wilton Manors reserves the right to refuse entry into Colohatchee Park for the reasons of health, safety, and prior offenses or for the comfort of all patrons and/or their pets.

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ACCEPTANCE OF RISK & RELEASE OF LIABILITY & WAIVER FORM

I/We _____, (Applicant 1), and _____, (Applicant 2), (when applicable), do hereby acknowledge and accept that I/we have voluntarily applied to participate and utilize, with my/our dog(s), the City of Wilton Manors Dog Park located at Colohatchee Park in Wilton Manors, FL. I/We fully understand and acknowledge that unleashing my/our dog or being otherwise physically present at the Dog Park involves risk or injury to me/us, any individual accompanying me/us, other persons, my/our dog(s) and other dog(s), or my property, including but not limited to risks resulting from aggressive dogs, unpredictable behavior, lack of proper training, and negligence of the City or its agents or employees. I/We further understand and assume that despite the efforts of the City of Wilton Manors to ensure owners/handlers have complied, there is a risk that not all dogs present in the Dog Park are licensed or vaccinated for rabies as required by the City, by which could result in injury to a person or dog. Additional risks include, but are not limited to dog fights; dog bites; theft or unlawful capture; escape over and under the fences; vegetation, standing water that may be unhealthy or poisonous if consumed; burrs or seeds that may become lodged in the dog's coat, feet, eyes, nose, or ears; mosquitoes; spiders; ticks; fleas and other insects; and wild-life typically found in a park such as foxes; raccoons; opossums; rats; snakes; field mice; turtles, negligence of the City or its agents or employees, etc. I/we understand and acknowledge that usage of the Dog Park is self-directed and shall not be directly supervised by an agent or employee of the City of Wilton Manors. Additionally, I/we fully assume any and all risks associated with the usage of the Dog Park, including fixtures and equipment, in an unsupervised and self-directed manner. By signing this release, I/we hereby agree to indemnify and save harmless the City of Wilton Manors, its elected officials, agents, officers, employees, and assigns from and against all loss, costs, damages, expenses and liability resulting from my/our dog(s)' use of the Dog Park or my/our presence at the Dog Park, including death, sickness, injury, and disease to any person or dog, or destruction to property, real or personal, arising directly or indirectly from my/our dog(s)' use of the Dog Park or from my/our presence at the Dog Park. I/We do hereby acknowledge that I/we have carefully read this release of liability, and fully understand, agree with, and accept the terms and conditions that have been outlined above. Further, I/we acknowledge that I/we have received a copy of the Rules and Regulations for The Dog Park and agree to abide by these rules, as may be amended. I/We accept and acknowledge personal responsibility and liability for any injury or damage caused as a directly or indirectly as a result of the wrongful or aggressive behavior of my/our dog, whether the loss occurs as a result of biting, jumping, scratching, digging, charging or any other behavior. I/We do hereby waive any and all rights that I/we or another on my/our behalf may have to institute legal proceedings to recover any damages, claims, liabilities or costs of any kind against the City or its elected officials, agents, officers, employees, and assigns for my/our use of the Dog Park. I/We have carefully read this release of liability, and fully understand, agree with, and accept its terms and conditions as outlined. I/We hereby do certify that I/we am/are over the age of 18 years and of sound mind. I/We have received and reviewed a copy of the rules and regulations for the Dog Park's use and agree to abide by these rules, as may be amended as listed. This Acceptance of Risk and Release of Liability and Waiver shall survive beyond the expiration or terminations of my/our application to use the Dog Park.
